Story time

$$5 + 9 + 2 = 16$$

How: Look for two numbers that make 10 or a double, and add those first. Then add the third number. Any order gives the same total.

- Adding only two of the three numbers.
- Losing track of which numbers are already added.
- Counting all three from 1 instead of starting from a sum they know.
