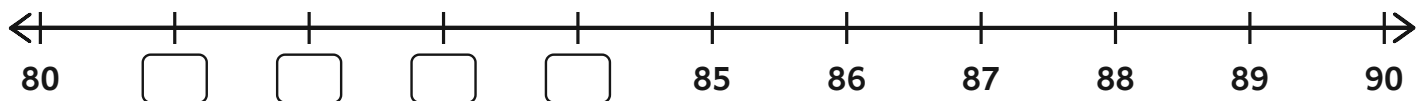
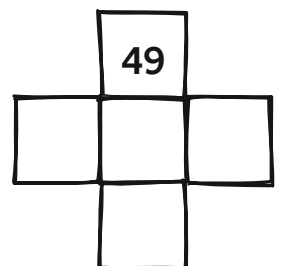
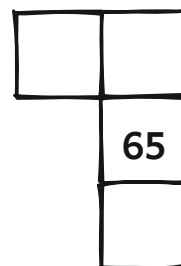
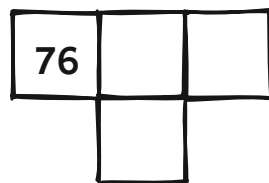
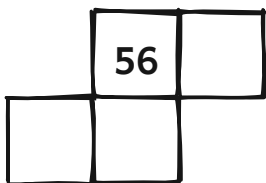


Chart pieces These pieces come from a chart that goes all the way to 120.

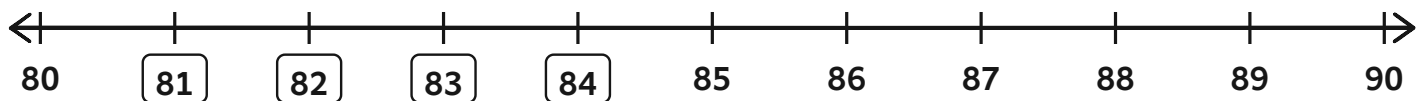
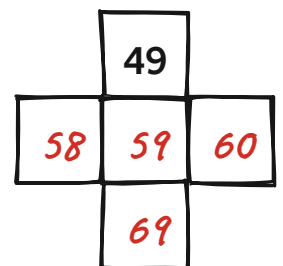
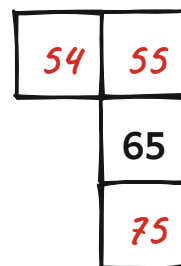
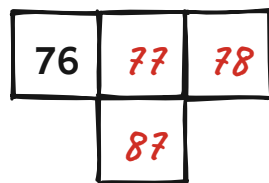
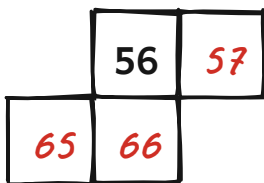


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GUIDE

① What this sheet practises

Counting up to 120 from any number, and reading and writing the numbers. Your child fills in missing numbers in counts, on number lines and on chart pieces.

② A problem from the sheet, worked out

Keep counting Fill in the missing numbers.

83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 88
35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40
65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 70
59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64

How: Say the numbers aloud from the last one you know. After a 9 in the ones place, the tens go up by one and the ones start again at 0: 49, 50.

③ Words to know

count on start at a number and count forward

digit one of the symbols 0 to 9

before the number just smaller

after the number just bigger

④ Watch for

- Skipping the change of tens: 48, 49, 40.
- Writing 110 as 10010, or 104 as 1004.
- Writing a number backwards, like 71 for 17.

⑤ Where it fits

BEFORE
K.CC.A.1

Count to 100 by ones and by tens.

THIS SHEET
1.NBT.A.1

Count to 120 from any number, and read and write the numerals.

NEXT
2.NBT.A.2

Count within 1000, and skip-count by 5s, 10s and 100s.

⑥ Helping at home

Count cereal pieces or steps past 100 together. Start somewhere new each time, like 87 or 106.
