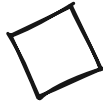

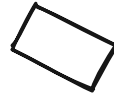

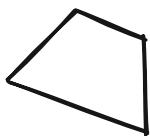
Find the triangles Big or small, turned any way: circle every triangle.



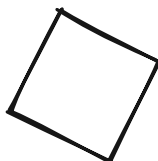

1 What this sheet practises

What makes a shape that shape: number of sides and corners, closed or open. Color, size and which way it's turned don't matter.

2 A problem from the sheet, worked out

Four sides Circle every shape with exactly 4 sides.



How: Count the straight sides and corners. A shape with 3 sides is a triangle, however big or tilted. Every closed shape with exactly 4 straight sides counts, even slanted ones.

3 Words to know

side a straight edge of a shape

corner where two sides meet

closed the sides join all the way round

triangle a closed shape with 3 sides

4 Watch for

- Skipping a shape because it's tilted or very small.
- Circling a shape with a curved side or a gap as a triangle.
- Circling only squares and rectangles, not other 4-sided shapes.

5 Where it fits
