GUIDE

1 What this sheet practises

Telling time to the hour and half hour on a clock with hands, and writing it the way a digital clock shows it, like 3:30.

2 A problem from the sheet, worked out

What time is it? Look at the short hand for the hour.

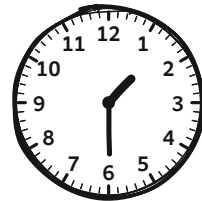

How: The short hand shows the hour. If the long hand points to 12, it is o'clock (6:00). If it points to 6, it is half past (6:30), and the short hand sits halfway past the hour.

3 Words to know

hour hand the short hand

minute hand the long hand

o'clock the long hand points to 12

half past 30 minutes after, the long hand on the 6

4 Watch for

- Mixing up the hands and reading the long hand as the hour.
- At half past, reading the next hour: 3:30 as 4:30.
- Writing 6:0 or 6:3 instead of 6:00 or 6:30.

5 Where it fits

6 Helping at home
