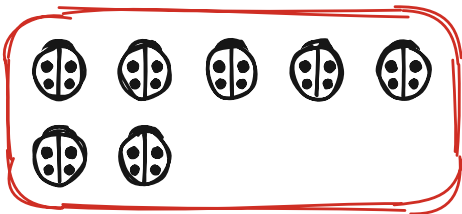
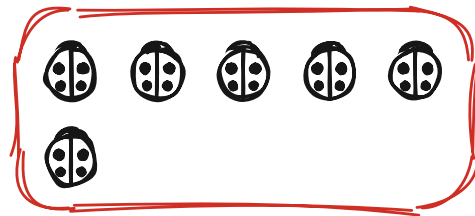

① What this sheet practises

Comparing two numbers from 1 to 10 and writing $>$, $<$ or $=$ between them. Your child also compares groups of pictures and puts numbers in order.

② A problem from the sheet, worked out

Greater or less? Use $>$ or $<$ or $=$. The open side faces the bigger number.

$8 > 6$

$10 > 1$

$1 < 6$

$3 < 5$

$4 > 3$

$2 < 3$

$9 > 8$

$7 = 7$

How: Decide which number is bigger: it comes later when you count. The open side of $>$ or $<$ faces the bigger number. If both are the same, write $=$.

③ Words to know

greater bigger; comes later when counting

less smaller; comes earlier when counting

equal the same amount

$>$ and $<$ signs whose open side faces the bigger number

④ Watch for

- Turning the sign the wrong way, so the point faces the bigger number.
- Writing $>$ or $<$ when both numbers are the same.
- Thinking 10 is less than 9 because it starts with a 1.

⑤ Where it fits
