① What this sheet practises

Counting on from any number, not just from 1. Your child starts at the number given and keeps counting to fill in the missing numbers.

② A problem from the sheet, worked out

What comes next? Start at the first number and keep counting.

23,	24,	25,	26,	27
37,	38,	39,	40,	41

How: Say the first number, then keep counting from there: 8, 9, 10, 11. There's no need to go back to 1 each time.

③ Words to know

count on keep counting from any number

next the number that comes right after

after later in counting order

before earlier in counting order

④ Watch for

- Starting over at 1 and losing their place.
- Skipping a number, most often in the teens, like 13 to 15.
- Not knowing what comes after 19 or 29.

⑤ Where it fits
