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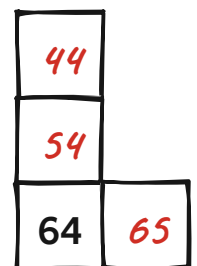
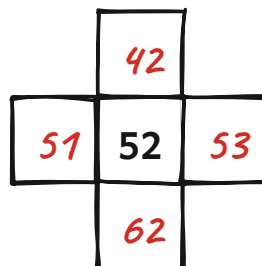
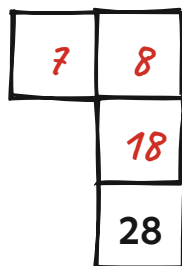
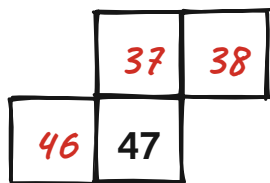
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GUIDE

① What this sheet practises

Counting to 100 by ones and by tens. Your child fills in the missing numbers in a counting line and says the tens: 10, 20, 30, all the way to 100.

② A problem from the sheet, worked out

Count by ones Fill in the missing numbers.

49, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54

45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50

76, 77, 78, 79, 80, 81

81, 82, 83, 84, 85, 86

How: Say the numbers out loud from the first one shown and write the ones that are missing. After a number ending in 9, a new ten starts: 89, 90.

③ Words to know

count say numbers in order, one at a time

count by tens 10, 20, 30, and so on

missing left out; a blank to fill in

hundred 100, or ten tens

④ Watch for

- Saying 89, 80 instead of 89, 90 when a new ten starts.
- Writing the digits the wrong way round, like 58 for 85.
- Skipping a number when two blanks sit side by side.

⑤ Where it fits

Count to 120 from any number, and read and write the numerals.

⑥ Helping at home

Count together on walks or while you wait: by ones up to 100, or by tens. Stop partway and let your child say what comes next.
