1 What this sheet practises

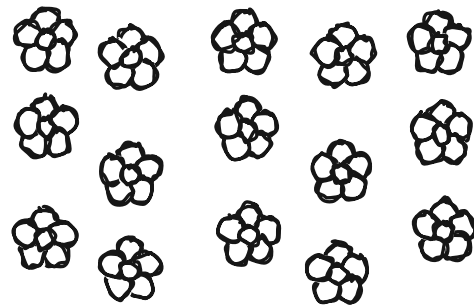
Counting up to 20 things, even when they're scattered, and keeping track so none is counted twice or missed.
