① What this sheet practises

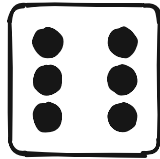
Seeing how many are in a small group at a glance, without counting one by one, on dot cards, ten frames and dominoes.

② A problem from the sheet, worked out

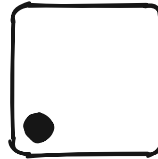
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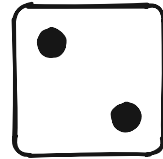

How: Take a quick look and say the number you see. Patterns help: dice dots, or a full row of 5 in a ten frame. Count to check if unsure.

③ Words to know

at a glance with one quick look

dot card a card with a few dots in a pattern

ten frame a box with 10 spaces, in two rows of 5

domino a tile with dots on each of its two halves

④ Watch for

- Counting every dot slowly instead of seeing the pattern.
- Mixing up 4 and 5 when the dots are scattered.
- On dominoes, writing one side's dots instead of both sides together.

⑤ Where it fits
