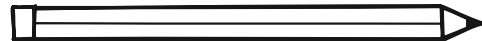

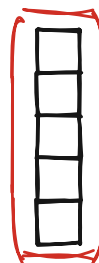


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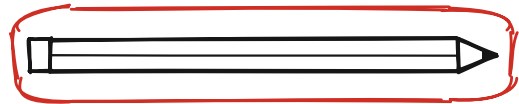
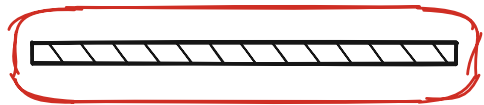
GUIDE

① What this sheet practises

Comparing two things to see which is longer or shorter, and which tower is tallest.

② A problem from the sheet, worked out

Which is longer? In each row, circle the longer one.



How: Look at where each one starts and where it ends: the one that reaches further is longer. For towers, the one reaching highest is tallest.

③ Words to know

longer reaches further from end to end

shorter doesn't reach as far

taller reaches higher from the bottom

compare look at two things to see how they differ

④ Watch for

- Picking the thicker one, like a fat crayon, instead of the longer one.
- Going by real life (pencils are longer than crayons) instead of the picture.
- Circling the shorter one when the row asks for the longer one.

⑤ Where it fits

⑥ Helping at home
