Which has fewer? Now circle the group with fewer.



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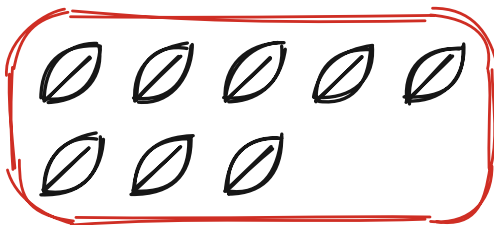
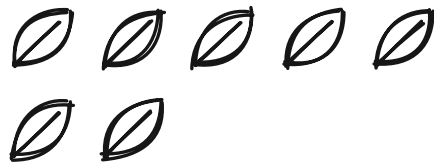
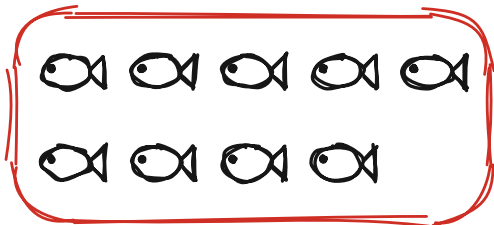
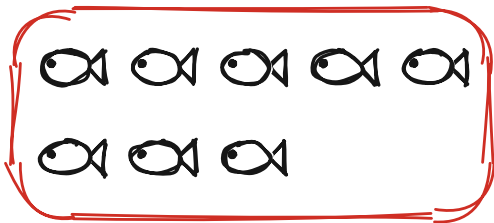

1 What this sheet practises

Deciding which of two groups has more and which has fewer, by counting or by matching them up.

2 A problem from the sheet, worked out

Which has more? In each row, circle the group that has more.



How: Count each group and compare the two numbers: the one that comes later has more. Or match one from each group; the group with some left over has more.

3 Words to know

more a bigger number of things

fewer a smaller number of things

same equal: the same number of things

compare look at two groups to see which has more

4 Watch for

- Picking the group that looks bigger or more spread out, not the one with more things.
- Mixing up more and fewer when the question switches.
- Counting one picture twice, so a group seems bigger than it is.
