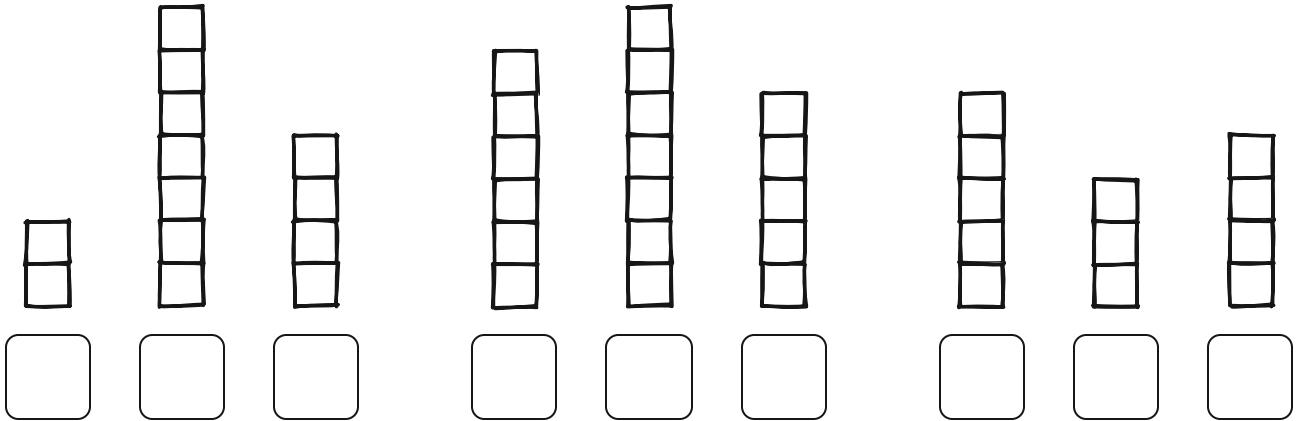

Write 1 under the tallest tower, then 2, then 3 under the shortest.



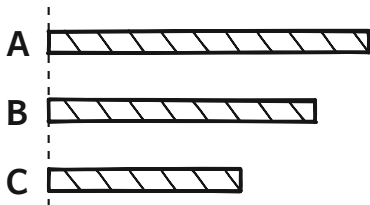
Biggest to smallest

Write 1 under the biggest, then 2, then 3 under the smallest.

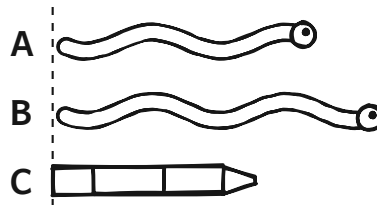


Shortest to longest

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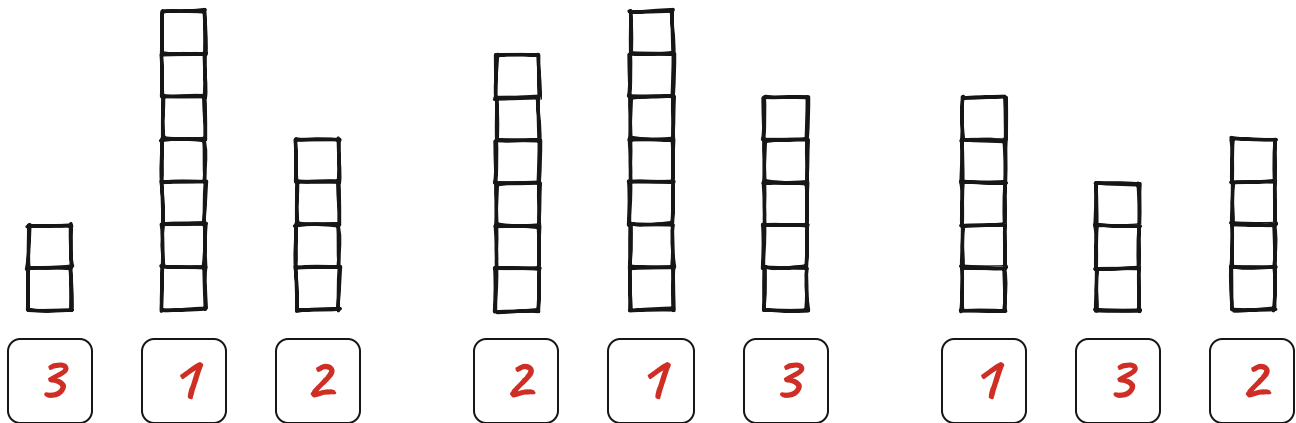

Write 1 under the tallest tower, then 2, then 3 under the shortest.



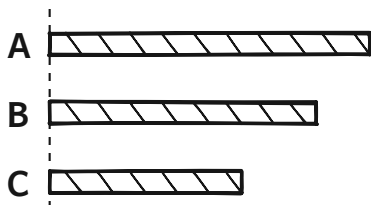
Biggest to smallest

Write 1 under the biggest, then 2, then 3 under the smallest.

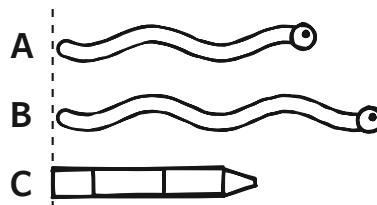


Shortest to longest

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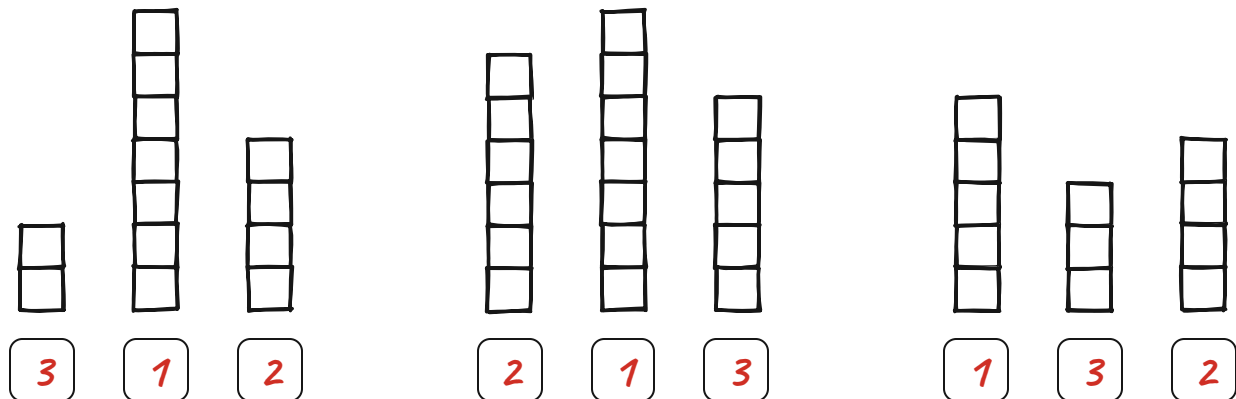
GUIDE

① What this sheet practises

Putting 3 things in order by size: tallest to shortest, biggest to smallest, or shortest to longest.

② A problem from the sheet, worked out

Tallest to shortest Write 1 under the tallest tower, then 2, then 3 under the shortest.



How: Find the tallest first and write 1 under it. The shortest gets 3, and the one left gets 2. Check that the heights go down step by step.

③ Words to know

tallest reaches highest of all

shortest the least tall or long of all

biggest the largest of all

order place things one after another by size

④ Watch for

- Starting at the wrong end and writing 1 under the shortest.
- Giving two things the same number.
- Judging length by thickness instead of where the right ends reach.

⑤ Where it fits
