1 What this sheet practises

Comparing shapes by counting their sides and corners, and counting the flat faces on solid shapes.

2 A problem from the sheet, worked out

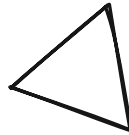

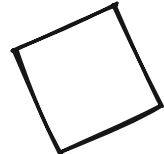

How: Put a finger on one side and count each straight side as you go around, stopping where you started. A small mark on the first side helps.

3 Words to know

side a straight edge of a flat shape

corner where two sides meet

face a flat surface on a solid shape

solid a shape you could pick up and hold

4 Watch for

- Counting the first side again when going around.
- Thinking a tilted shape has a different number of sides.
- Forgetting the hidden faces of a cube: it has 6, not 3.
