① What this sheet practises

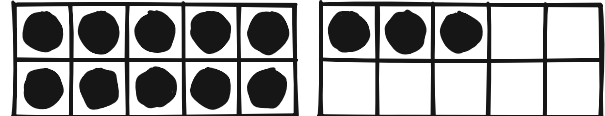
Seeing the numbers 11 to 19 as ten ones and some more ones: 13 is 10 and 3 more.

② A problem from the sheet, worked out

Ten and more One frame is full: that's 10. How many in all?

How: One ten frame is full, so start at 10 and count on the extra dots: 11, 12, 13. The number is ten and that many ones: $10 + 3 = 13$.

③ Words to know

ten a group of 10 ones

ones single things, counted one at a time

teen numbers 11 to 19: ten and some more

ten frame a box with 10 spaces, in two rows of 5

④ Watch for

- Counting the full frame one by one and losing track.
- Writing 13 as 31, since the word “thirteen” says the 3 first.
- Writing $10 + 7$ as 107 instead of 17.
